TOURIST VISAS for ITALIAN/EUROPEAN ECONOMIC AREA FAMILY MEMBERS

TRAVELLING WITH or JOINING ITALIAN/E.E.A. NATIONAL IN ITALY

Documents required for Schengen Visa applications

	E-Application form – duly completed on line, website http://e-applicationvisa.esteri.it (For the English version, click on “EN”). You need to print it, 4 pages and the bar code page, and sign it. For minors, (children under the age of 18) both parents/legal guardian must sign the application form.
	Passport - valid for at least 3 months from the date of return and there must be at least two blank pages in the document.
	A recent passport sized color photograph with a white background (3.50X4.50cm) full face, men without head cover.
	Flight reservation or flight ticket.
	Original and photocopy of the marriage certificate, birth certificate for children, registered in the country of origin of the E.E.A national, duly translated into English and certified by the Embassy/Consulate of the issuing country or a document certifying the family member status. The family members of Italian nationals don't need certificates if they are registered with the AIRE office of the Embassy of Italy in Muscat.
	Photocopy of a valid passport of the Italian/European Economic Area national.
	Hotel booking – or Declaration of hospitality from the host in Italy (see link “forms”). The invitation letter must be addressed to the Italian Embassy, dated and duly signed, together with a photocopy of the host ID/passport.

FOR FAMILY MEMBERS NOT TRAVELLING WITH OR NOT JOINING THE E.E.A. NATIONAL please refer to the regular check-list for tourist visa.

The Directive 2004/38 / EC provides facilities for the following family members:

- a) spouse;
- b) the partner with whom the Union citizen has contracted a registered partnership, on the basis of the legislation of a Member State, if the legislation of the host Member State treats registered partnerships as equivalent to marriage and in accordance with the conditions laid down in the relevant legislation of the host Member State;
- c) the direct descendants who are under the age of 21 or are dependents and those of the spouse or partner as defined in point (b);
- d) the dependent direct relatives in the ascending line and those of the spouse or partner as defined in point (b);

If the conditions established by law are met, a tourism visa will be issued free of charge for a family member.

Processing time can range from 3 to 7 days.

Nationals of some countries are subject to consultation procedure which may extend processing time up to 15 days. If you are not an Omani national, please check if a prior consultation is required for your nationality (see “Countries subject to prior consultation” in link “forms”).
