MEDICAL TREATMENT VISAS

Documents required for Schengen Visa applications

<p>E-Application form – duly completed on line, printed and signed: website http://e-applicationvisa.esteri.it If the applicant is a minor (under the age of 18) both parents/legal guardian must sign the application form</p>
<p>Passport – its validity must extend at least three months after the intended date of departure and it must contain at least two blank pages.</p>
<p>Photocopy of relevant passport pages, such as: data page, previous Schengen, UK and USA visas.</p>
<p>for non-Omani Nationals, copy of Omani residence visa and resident card. The residence permit must be valid for at least 3 month after the end of the planned stay.</p>
<p>A recent passport sized color photograph with a white background (35–40mm in width). <u>Head covering are only accepted for religious reasons</u>. Please see the following link: https://www.icao.int/Security/mrtd/Downloads/Technical%20Reports/Annex_A-Photograph_Guidelines.pdf</p>
<p>Healthcare documentation, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) medical record issued in the Country of residence/origin certifying the actual illness condition of the patient, duly translated into English;b) declaration of the Italian health care facility, public or private (if private, it must be accredited to the National Health Service), specifying type and start date of the treatment, duration and estimated cost;c) certificate issued by the Italian health facility confirming the patient has provided a 30% deposit of the estimated cost for the healthcare requested.
<p>Return ticket (or booking) or evidence that the applicant has his/her own means of transport. For internal travels or travel to other Schengen Country, applicants must provide flight/train/car rental bookings or reservations.</p>
<p>Documents indicating that the applicant possesses sufficient means of subsistence for the duration of the stay, the payment of medical treatment and for the return to his/her Country of origin or residence, such as the salary certificate from the applicant's employer and the original stamped bank statement for the last three months. For applicants who are self-employed also a valid original commercial registration certificate.</p> <p>Unemployed/house wife/student applicants must submit a signed declaration of financial support with a copy of the passport, original stamped bank statement and salary certificate from the person who is sponsoring the trip.</p>
<p><u>In case of minors</u>: Parental authorization signed by both the parents/legal guardian), authorizing the minor to travel. A copy of their passports must be attached. If one of the parents is abroad, he/she need to contact the Visa Section of the Embassy by email: visti.masqate@esteri.it</p> <p>A legalized birth certificate, in original or a certified copy, translated into English or Italian, must be provided as well.</p>

DECLARATION:

I have been informed that:

- An application without a complete set of documents according to the present checklist may lead to the refusal of my visa application;
- The submission of a complete file does not guarantee the issuance of a visa;
- The Embassy of Italy in Muscat reserves the right to ask for additional documents and personal interview;
- Once the application is submitted the passport cannot be withdrawn.
