RE-ENTRY

Documents required for National Visa applications

<p>Application form – duly completed, printed and signed. The form can be download from the website of the Italian Embassy. <u>In case of minors, the form should be signed by both parents.</u></p>
<p>Passport – its validity must extend at least three months after the intended date of departure and it must contain at least two blank pages.</p>
<p>A recent passport sized color photograph with a white background (35–40mm in width). <u>Head covering are only accepted for religious reasons.</u> Please see the following link: https://www.icao.int/Security/mrtd/Downloads/Technical%20Reports/Annex_A-Photograph_Guidelines.pdf</p>
<p>An affidavit from the applicant (if it is in Arabic, it must be translated in English) detailing the reason for the re-entry visa application, and giving details of the applicant’s residence in Italy.</p>
<p><u>If the application for renewal of the residence permit has been submitted, but the applicant left Italy before its issuance, copy of the receipt of the renewal application to the competent Italian Authority must be submitted.</u></p>
<p><u>If the applicant has overstayed or not renewed the permit</u> due to a medical condition, he/she must provide the original medical certificates from the beginning of the treatment, issued from the hospital, stating the reason of the illness and the duration of the treatment.</p>
<p><u>If the applicant was previously staying in Italy for work,</u> he/she must provide a letter signed by the employer stating his/her employment.</p>
<p><u>If the applicant was previously staying in Italy for family purpose,</u> he/she must provide copies of the residence permit and spouse/parents staying in Italy, as well as invitation letter from the above mentioned family with copies of Italian residence permit/ID.</p>

- An application without a complete set of documents will be rejected;
- The Embassy reserves the right to ask for additional supporting documents;
- Any forged/fake documents will be reported to the relevant Authorities.
