**TOURIST VISAS for ITALIAN/EUROPEAN ECONOMIC AREA FAMILY MEMBERS
TRAVELLING WITH or JOINING ITALIAN/E.E.A. NATIONAL IN ITALY**
Documents required for Schengen Visa applications

<p>E-Application form – duly completed on line, printed and signed: website http://e-applicationvisa.esteri.it</p> <p>If the applicant is a minor (under the age of 18) both parents/legal guardian must sign the application form. Minor and both parents must be present at the VFS center during the application process.</p>
<p>Passport – its validity must extend at least three months after the intended date of departure and it must contain at least two blank pages.</p>
<p>Photocopy of relevant passport pages, such as: data page, previous Schengen, UK and USA visas.</p>
<p>Photocopy of Omani residence visa and resident card. The residence permit must be valid for at least three months after the intended date of departure and it must be on the current passport.</p>
<p>A recent passport sized color photograph with a white background (35–40mm in width). <u>Head covering are only accepted for religious reasons.</u> Please see the following link: https://www.icao.int/Security/mrtd/Downloads/Technical%20Reports/Annex_A-Photograph_Guidelines.pdf</p>
<p>Original and photocopy of the marriage certificate, birth certificate for children, registered in the country of origin of the E.E.A national, duly translated into English and certified by the Embassy/Consulate of the issuing country or a document certifying the family member status. The family members of Italian nationals don't need certificates if they are registered with the AIRE office of the Embassy of Italy in Muscat.</p>
<p>Photocopy of a valid passport of the Italian/European Economic Area national.</p>
<p>Return ticket (or booking) or evidence that the applicant has his/her own means of transport. For internal travels or travel to other Schengen Country, applicants must provide flight/train/car rental bookings or reservations.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">- <u>If the applicant is traveling together with the EU/EEA/Swiss citizen</u>, proof of traveling or joining the E.U./E.E.A./Swiss national- <u>If the applicant is not traveling together with the EU/EEA/Swiss citizen</u>, proof of accommodation during all the intended stay, such as: hotel reservations, copy of a rental contract or declaration of hospitality.
<p>If the applicant is a minor: parental authorization signed by both parents/legal guardian authorizing the minor to travel, with a photocopy of their passports. If one of the parents is abroad, he/she must contact the Visa Section of the Embassy by email: visti.muscat@esteri.it</p>

If the conditions established by law are met, a tourism visa will be issued free of charge for a family member.

FAMILY MEMBERS NOT TRAVELLING WITH OR NOT JOINING THE EEA NATIONAL, please refer to the regular check-list for tourist visa.

The Directive 2004/38 / EC provides facilities for the following family members:

- a) spouse;
- b) the partner with whom the Union citizen has contracted a registered partnership, on the basis of the legislation of a Member State, if the legislation of the host Member State treats registered partnerships as equivalent to marriage and in accordance with the conditions laid down in the relevant legislation of the host Member State;
- c) the direct descendants who are under the age of 21 or are dependents and those of the spouse or partner as defined in point (b);
- d) the dependent direct relatives in the ascending line and those of the spouse or partner as defined in point (b)

DECLARATION:

- An application without a complete set of documents according to the present checklist may lead to the refusal of my visa application;
- The submission of a complete file does not guarantee the issuance of a visa;
- The Embassy of Italy in Muscat reserves the right to ask for additional documents and personal interview;
- Once the application is submitted the passport cannot be withdrawn.
